- Do not overwrite
- Fill-in all details, mentioning NA (Non-applicable) wherever necessary
- Forms not filled-in properly would be rejected without notifying the candidate

Payment of Fee (at the time of Admission)

1. Selected candidates would have to pay the fee of **Rs. 79,250** (seventy nine thousand, two hundred and fifty only) within 24 hours of the merit list being put up i.e by Wednesday, 14th June 2017 during college hours i.e 10:30 am to 3:30 pm only through Pay Order / Demand Draft drawn in favour of 'J. D. Birla Institute' or through NEFT / RTGS transfer (Payment will not be accepted in cash). In case of online payment through NEFT / RTGS transfer, a pay in slip with UTR number will have to be produced at the time of document verification at the college. Students having to undergo bridge course/s would have to pay Rs. 1,500/- in addition for each bridge course. Accordingly the amount maybe added to the total below.
