### ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- A student who is selected for enrolment in a particular course offered by the College will have to complete admission procedures and get herself registered within the notified time period.
- Application for admission has to be made on the prescribed form obtained from the office of the Institute, on the designated days (Monday to Friday between 10:00 am to 1:00 pm and again from 1.30 p.m to 3.00 pm) only. Students may also apply online.
- **Application forms are non-transferable.**
- **Form** must be collected in the name of the **applicant only**.
- Forms should be complete in all respect with colored passport size photo pasted firmly on appropriate box.
- Cost of the Application Form is **Rs. 1,300/-** only. Online applicants can pay the money (Rs. **1,500/-**) through Net Banking, Debit Card, or Credit Card

#### Eligibility

1. Only female candidates are eligible for admission to the M.Sc courses.
2. Candidates must have good knowledge of the English language.
3. A student seeking admission to the different M.Sc courses must have passed the exams mentioned below either from Jadavpur University or any other University recognized by Jadavpur University and must have at least 55% at the Bachelor's level:
  - a) For M.Sc in Food & Nutrition: The Candidate must have passed B.Sc (Hons.) in Home Science (specialization in Food & Nutrition), Food & Nutrition, Food Science & Nutrition Management, Food Science & Processing, Clinical Nutrition & Dietetics.
  - b) For M.Sc in Textiles and Clothing: The Candidate must have passed B.Sc (Hons.) in Home Science, Home Science (specialization in Textiles & Clothing), Textile Science, Clothing & Fashion Studies.
  - c) For M.Sc in Human Development: The Candidate must have passed B.Sc (Hons.) in Home Science, Home Science (specialization in Human Development), Child Development, Human Development & Family Studies, Developmental Studies.
4. A candidate who has appeared in the examination at the under-graduate (degree) level may also apply in anticipation of the results, provided she produces her internal assessment showing the overall average marks obtained by her. The admission would be provisional subject to subsequent satisfaction of the admission criteria.
5. Foreign Students may be admitted as per Jadavpur University norms.

#### Selection Procedure

1. Eligible candidates for M.Sc / PGDDAN courses would be short-listed based on the criteria mentioned below.

2. Short-listed candidates will have to pay the fees within 24 hours of the merit list being put up or else the seat will be given to the candidate next on the merit list. Admission will be

confirmed only after verification of all necessary documents (with the originals) by the college within the stipulated time.

**NOTE:** Students graduating from Universities other than Jadavpur University will have to submit their migration certificate within one month of being admitted to the M.Sc Course; till then the admission will be considered provisional.
